Baptism and First Confession.

The young people who are being baptised will need a Godparent(s) to attend and their parent (s). The Godparent (s) ought to be a communicant and a practising Catholic and can be a family member.

First Communion and Being Received into the Church

Young people who are making their first communion and being received into the Catholic Church please be in St Teilo's Church on

Date; 10 May Time; 11am

Confirmation and Reconciliation Retreat

I welcome you all to a Reconciliation Retreat. This is a very necessary part of the preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Could parent (s) and sponsor (s) please attend the first hour of the Retreat at St Teilo's Church on

Date; 15 May Time; 3.30-5.30.

Every candidate for Confirmation will need a sponsor, this can be a family member. The sponsor ought to be a communicant and a practising Catholic. Each candidate should choose a Saints name, and we will be providing badges so their new name can be worn on the day.

The conferment of the Sacrament of Confirmation by Archbishop Mark is on

Date; 16 May 2026 Time 11.30am

Archbishop Mark will meet with the candidates at **11 am**, thirty minutes before the Mass begins. This means that those to be confirmed ought to be in the Church and seated at **10.45 am.**
