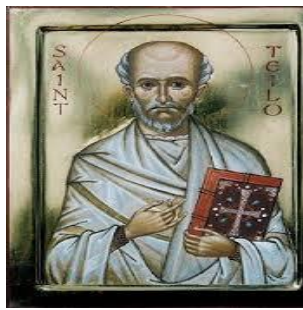

Matthew 16:21-27
